# Interview with the unbeatable Superstar DJ David Morales

Legendary remixer and producer David Morales recently sat down with Examiner [Leny Navarro](#) to discuss his newest projects. As one of the most prolific remixers of all time, the Grammy Award-winning artist has recently scored a No. 1 on Billboard's Dance Club Songs [chart](#) with his newest release "There Must Be Love."

Additionally David Morales has remixed hits by

Madonna and other **stars**, including several of Mariah Carey's 17 Dance #1s. Morales is also renowned for his association with the late Frankie Knuckles.

**Leny Navarro: I absolutely love the heartfelt "There Must Be Love Feat. Janice Robinson," is it a prelude to the release of a brand new album?**

**David Morales:** No, we just did it as a one off single. I haven't really given much thought to producing a new album. I'm definitely more into producing singles at the moment. Truthfully, to produce an **album** takes a tremendous amount of time. What I produce today is I want to release tomorrow.

**LN: What was the first musical experience that really touched you?**

**DM:** I would probably have to say when I went to the Loft to hear David Mancuso. I experienced **DJing** on a whole other level. David even taught me about sound and the relationship between music and sound.

**LN: "The Face" made a return, what's behind its reintroduction?**

**DM:** The Face is simply my **disco** side. Funnily enough, it started as a tool that I created for myself and that I shared with a few DJ's. Louie Vega ,being one of them, who inspired me to release it with a vocal, so I asked Kym Mazele if

she was interested and she kindly said yes.

**LN: Truthfully, what's your take on the current state of the international club scene?**

**DM:** I like the European scene more than the American. Honestly, there's too much **EDM** in the US. There's more variety in Europe. All in all, the scene is bigger than ever! I'm completely happy to see how far it has come in my 4 decades of DJing.

**LN: You have worked with everyone from Madonna to Mariah Carey, which new Diva/Divo would you pick to create magic with?**

**DM:** I love Alicia Keys, Justin Timberlake, Adele, Ne-Yo, Omar ... I can only say there is a lot of new **talent** out there.

**LN: Since you travel so much, what is the one item you take with you wherever you go?**

**DM:** My **laptop** (lol) and my American Express card.

**LN: Finally, tell us a bit more about the impressive works of art inked on your body.**

**DM:** The majority of my **ink** was done by Neil Ahern from Inkadelic in Ibiza. Most of it represents moments or shall I say chapters of my life...
